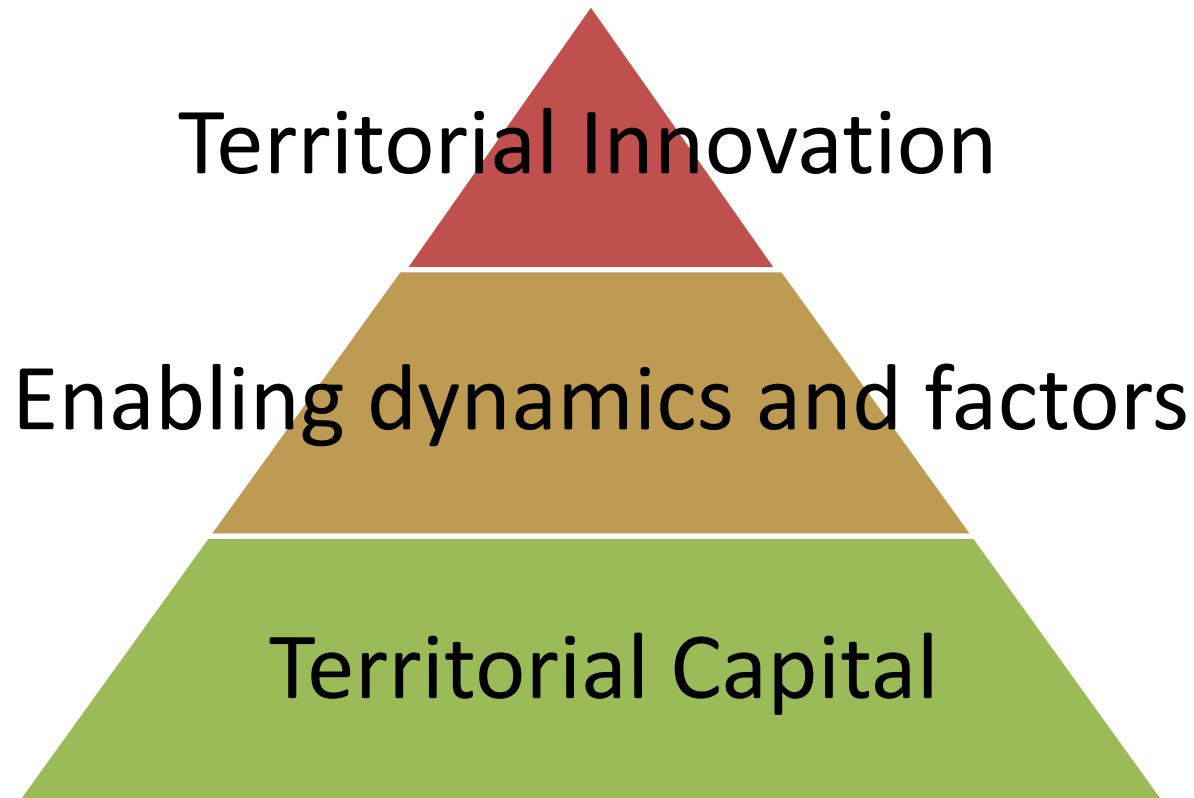

- Centre of Competences should be established by cooperation between industry, local community and research organizations. All mentioned stakeholders have to be involved in running such Centres – corresponding to CreativeMED model
- Series of workshops followed and it is still under way where stakeholders contribute in planning and policy making
- First requests for proposals are expected in early 2015
