### How to get to the Villa Méditerranée?

In Marseille, between the Vieux-Port (Old Port) and the Joliette port, the Villa Méditerranée is in an outstanding setting on the Esplanade of the J4 pier at the feet of Marseille Cathedral and at the end of the new skyline and of the Euroméditerranée business district.

#### *On foot or by bike*

From the city center (Vieux Port), it takes you about 5-10 minutes **by foot** to reach the Villa Méditerranée. Follow the right side quay.



**Rent a bike:**

The city of Marseille offers you the possibility to rent bikes at around 130 stations throughout the city. You can buy a short-term ticket with your bank card (7-day ticket).

#### *Public Transport*

**By metro and tram**

**Metro line 2** (red line) or **Tramway 2** (yellow line) bring you to the station **JOLIETTE**.

From there it is a 10-minute walk to the Villa Méditerranée.

Alternatively you can take a bus Fort Saint Jean/Tourette Cathédrale (Ligne 49, Ligne 60, Ligne 82 and Ligne 582)

## By car

### From Lyon(A7):

Junction towards A557 in the direction of *Joliette/Les Ports*, then A55 exit at J4

### From Nice (A50):

Tunnel Prado-Carénage exit at *Joliette/Major*
