- MacroRegional or Sea Basin Strategies**

Links to other strategies and programmes

Programmes take into account the Macro-regional and Sea-basin Strategies which are relevant to them.

For MED those are the (different levels of impact):

- Atlantic Sea-Basin
- Adriatic-Ionian (EUSAIR)
- Danube (EUSDR)

Priorities quite similar (mainly Atlantic and EUSAIR):

- *Entrepreneurship-Innovation-R&D, Protection-Security-Development of (marine and coastal) environment, Accessibility, Connectivity, Culural heritage and (maritime and coastal) tourism, ...*

Links to Partnership Agreements, coutry-specific OPs, CBC/IR programmes, HORIZON, COSME.

Possible use of flexibility

Draft Regulation allows co-financing at max. 20%, actions outside the programme area (i.e. in the areas of other programmes)
